Introducing Off Highway Fuel Usage Report**

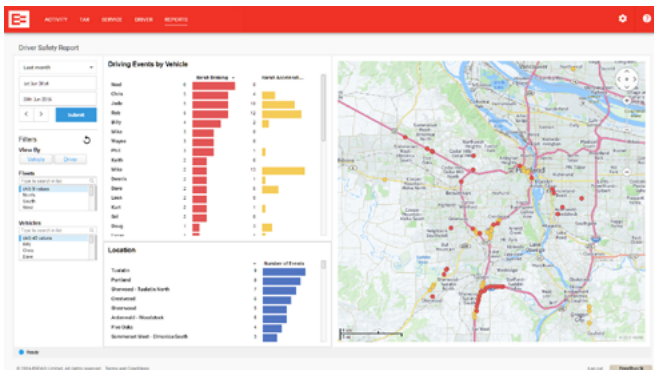
Take advantage of fuel tax refund claims available across jurisdictions by using Depot’s Off Highway Fuel Usage Report. The report makes it quicker and easier to complete and file fuel tax refund claims where available, helping to ensure that claims for fuel consumed off highway are accurate, and refunds are maximized.

Select and filter the information you want to see including the type of vehicle, off highway data for a particular jurisdiction, and specific road category type, such as forestry road or construction site. See where your vehicles travel the most off highway to make better business decisions, and get rewarded by taking advantage of the off highway refund opportunities.

**Accelerate Fleet Safety –
Introducing the Driver Safety Report**

The Driver Safety Report supports your safe driving program. Poor driving is a risk to your drivers and the public, increases vehicle wear and tear, and leads to higher fuel costs. The Driver Safety Report gives you a simple view of your fleet’s harsh braking and sharp acceleration events and the number and types of events per driver or vehicle, and pinpoints location danger spots, so you can give targeted feedback to your drivers.



EROAD Driver App users

We recommend you always update to the latest version of EROAD Driver (version 3.1.9), to ensure your drivers can take advantage of new Electronic Logbook and DVIR features and improvements. Updating is easy – simply open Google Play™ and find EROAD Driver. If the Update option is available, the version currently installed on your device is not the latest. Tap Update to install the latest version and follow the instructions.

Introducing Driver tab

The Driver tab has all the information you need to manage your drivers. The Driver tab simplifies administration by helping you keep an eye on licenses and expiry dates, and giving you quick access to driver reports.

Note, this update replaces the previous version of Driver, which was accessed through the Settings menu. To open the new tab, click on ‘DRIVER’ in the red navigation bar.

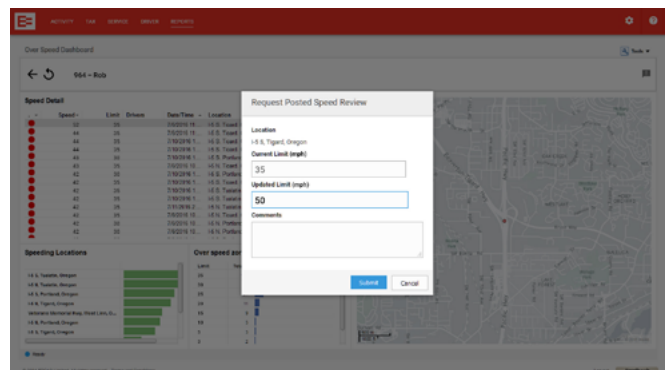
Electronic Logbook – Driver Timesheets improvements

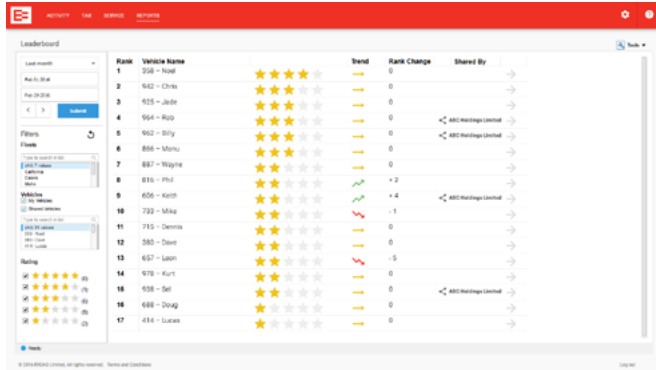


EROAD Share – Work safer together

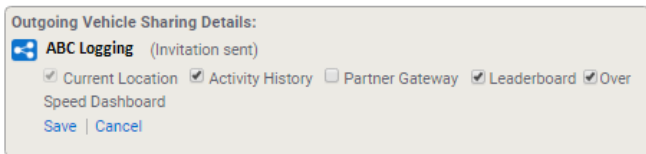
EROAD Share supports organizations that work together and enables secure sharing of vehicles in Depot.

Safe driving can be encouraged and acknowledged across organizations, helping you lift the overall standard.



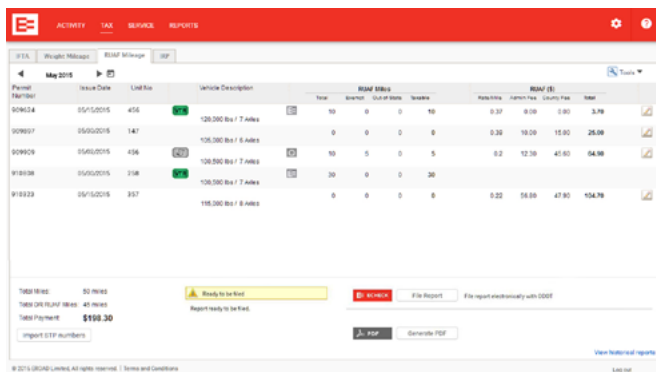

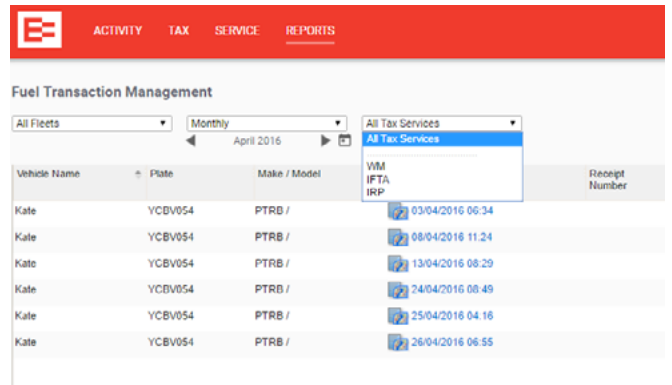
RUAF e-File – File your RUAF reports electronically

There is no more need to print and mail your RUAF report each month, reducing cost and errors, and speeding up transaction processing.



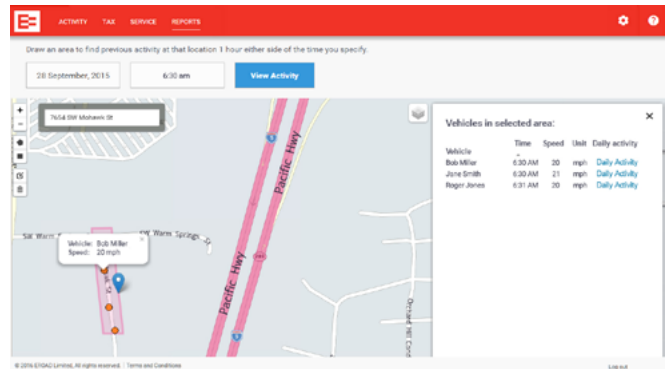
Fuel Transaction Management – Monitor fuel transactions per tax type

Our popular Retrospective Activity Report is now even easier to use - multiple events will be listed in chronological order and can be further sorted by time or speed.



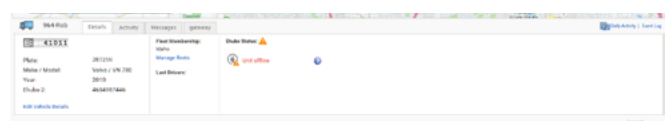
Ehubo – Status panel improvements
